

The Cambridge-Michigan Examination for the Certificate of Competency in English (ECCE) is a standardized **high-intermediate** level English as a foreign language (EFL) examination. You might use an ECCE certificate:

- As evidence of high-intermediate competence in English for personal, public, educational, and occupational purposes;
- To provide evidence of your level of English for possible admission in Graduate Programs in Brazil; and
- When applying for a job promotion, or communicating with contacts worldwide.

The ECCE is aimed at the B2 level of the Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR) and is valid for the lifetime of the recipient. The ECCE is similar in level to the Cambridge First Certificate in English (FCE).
